MEDIA NOTE: The list of drive-thru flu shot clinics was previously released in late August. This is a reminder with the first drive-thru clinic starting tomorrow, Sept. 16 in Sarasota.

Roll up your sleeve – Drive-Thru Flu Shot Clinics now available

Getting a seasonal flu shot is easy with several drive-thru flu shot clinics scheduled this season. Public health officials say that getting a flu shot is your best defense against this serious illness. Everyone six months and older is encouraged to get a flu shot. To protect babies under six months of age who are too young for a flu shot, all members of their households need to be vaccinated.

The first four drive-thru flu seasonal flu shot clinics are scheduled as follows:

The seasonal flu vaccine will not protect against the H1N1 (swine) flu virus. The H1N1 flu vaccine may be available in mid-October.

Sarasota Flu and Pneumonia Coalition partner organizations Maxim Healthcare Services, Optima Health Care, Sarasota Health Care, Visiting Nurses Association (VNA), Sarasota Memorial Health Care Systems, Nokomis Walk-In, Sarasota Immediate Care Walk-In and Sarasota Family Medical Walk-In clinics are also providing many other flu shot opportunities. The cost of a flu shot at these locations will be between \$20 - \$30. Pneumonia vaccine will be \$45 - \$50. Cash and check are accepted. If you have Medicare B, bring a copy of your card with you.

Authorization Forms are available in advance at the drive-thru sites, Sarasota County libraries or on-line at www.sarasotahealth.org. Blank forms will be available on-site.

Other ways to prevent the flu include:

- Cover your face and nose when you cough or sneeze with tissue or the inside of your elbow.
- Wash hands often with soap and water or an alcohol-based hand cleaner.
- Stay home when sick and keep sick children home until free from fever for at least 24 hours, without fever-reducing medications.
